Please join CPSA DC 119 for a 1-day workshop of **Scott Krohn's Dramatic Dahlia** scratchboard artwork, held on November 2, 2024, from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm via Zoom.

You can either ZOOM from your home or attend with other participants at the Springdale Nazarene Church (SNC), 11177 Springfield Pike, Cincinnati, OH 45246 ([map](#)). We will be in the usual conference room used for quarterly meetings.

If attending at SNC, donuts for breakfast and sandwiches for lunch will be provided, with coffee and water. You are invited to bring a pot luck offering for the group.

The cost is \$85 for DC 119 members and \$95 for non-members.

Scratchboard art is a way to create an image using a special board with a black surface layer and light colored underlayer. Using a sharp tool, you cut into the black surface to reveal the lighter layer and create an image from the series of light lines against the dark background. This image will then be colored using Derwent Intense pencils.

Once registered, you will receive an email with a link to download the "How to Prepare" PDF of instructions for the class. **SAVE this PDF.** On the day of the workshop, just before 10:00 am EST, click on the link found in the instructions to enter the classroom. As Scott demos in class, you will follow along with the drawing. During the live workshop, feel free to ask Scott questions. And a few days after the workshop concludes, you will receive a link to a video recording of the entire workshop.

- 2 – 5" x 7" Ampersand Scratchboards (*they typically come in packs of 3*)
- X-Acto knife, #11 blade with 2-3 additional blades
- #1 watercolor brush (*or similar paintbrush*)
- Paper towels
- Water cup and water
- Your preferred pencil sharpener
- Carbon paper (*to transfer the line drawing*)
- Masking tape
- Pencil
- All pencils listed below *sharpened before class:*

Derwent Inktense:

- Cadmium Yellow
- Sun Yellow
- Thistle
- Fuchsia

Optional (strongly recommended):

- Eyebrow Tattoo Microblading Needles (*such as these [here](#) on Amazon**)
- Additional X-Acto knife handle (*to hold the eyebrow tattoo needle*)

Optional:

- Large make-up brush (*to use as dusting brush*)
- 400 grit sandpaper (*to help blades stay sharp*)
